


### Mission



### **COURSE CURRICULUM**

The D.El.Ed. course is designed to integrate the study of subject knowledge, human development, Pedagogical knowledge and communication skills. The programme comprises three broad curricular areas: Perspectives in Education, Curriculum and Pedagogic Studies, and Engagement with the Field. Transaction of the course is done using a variety of approaches, such as case studies, discussion on reflective journals, observations of children, and interactions with the community in multiple sociocultural environments, Information and communication Technology (ICT), gender, yoga education, and disability/inclusive education forms and integral part of the D.El.Ed. curriculum.

#### **THEORY COURSES:**

(A) Perspectives in Education: Perspective in Education includes courses in the study of childhood, child development and adolescence, contemporary India and education, Philosophical and sociological perspectives in Education, theoretical foundations of knowledge and curriculum, teaching and learning, gender in the context of school and society, and inclusive Education.

(B) Curriculum and Pedagogic Studies : Courses in curriculum and pedagogic Studies include aspects of language across the curriculum and communication, understanding of a discipline, social history of a school subject and its pedagogical foundations, with a focus on the learner: and a course on the theoretical perspectives on assessment for learning.



#### **COURSES DURATION**


### **ICT & ET LABORATORY**

### Norms & Guidelines of Admission

### D.EL.Ed. (Diploma in Elementary Education)

### **Minimum Educational Qualification Required**

- 10 +2 or Intermediate in any discipline/subject.
- · Minimum 50% marks in 10 +2 or Intermediate.
- Age Minimum 17 Years or above.

### **Documents Required:**

- 1. Certificates and marks sheet of 10th (Matric) & +2 (intermediate).
- 2. College Leaving Certificates (CLC).
- 3. Caste Certificate (in case of SC/ST/OBC) from competent authority
- 4. 5 Coloured passport sized Photographs.

### B.Ed. (Bachelor of Education)

### **Minimum Educational Qualification Required**

- · Graduate or equivalent degree in any discipline/subject.
- Minimum 50% marks in graduation.
- Student appearing/appeared in final year (Part III) examination can also apply for admission. Such students will have to submit their degree/marks sheet within one month of admission in the college.

### **Documents Required:**

- 1. Certificates and marks sheet of 10th (Matric) and graduation part I, II, III) or equivalent examinations.
- 2. College Leaving Certificates (CLC).
- 3. Caste Certificate (in case of SC/ST/OBC) from competent authority
- 4.5 Coloured passport sized Photographs.

IMPORTANT: As per the NCTE Rules, any student cannot take admission in any other course while pursuing B.Ed. Course. He / She is strictly prohibited to sit for/appear in any examination of any University or Board after taking admission in B.Ed. Programme. The admission will be cancelled with immediate effect if any candidate is found in violation of norms. An employed candidate will have to submit the releasing/leave order from head of the concerned organization at the time of admission. Admission of any candidate will be provisional and may be cancelled if any discrete is found or the candidate shall fail to comply with the rules, regulations and other conditions as laid down by the college. 80% of attendance is required. Candidates who fail to fulfil the required percentage will be debarred from appearing in the final B.Ed. Examination.

### **COURSE CURRICULUM**

The course curriculum of S.T. College of Education is based on the guidelines of Maulana Mazharul Haque Arabic and Persian University, Patna. It consists of both theory and practical classes for integrated skill building of aspirant teacher to be able to teach and guide students at various levels. The syllabus may be modified/revised as per the NCTE / University guidelines.

### **Procedures**

### Entrance Test

There will be an Entrance Test. The test will be announced on college website or notice board. A Candidate whose application form is complete with the required documents and those who have qualified in the entrance test will be included in the merit list and will be eligible for counseling. The list of selected candidates will be displayed on the college Notice Board/website.

#### Uniform

An Academic Kit along with uniform will be provided to the students at the time of admission.

### **Documents** required at the time of Admission

Selected candidates called for admission must produce following documents in original:

- Mark sheet from Matriculation to last received degree.
- College leaving certificate/Department leaving certificate.
- Migration certificate of university from which the candidate received his last Bachelor/Master degree other than Maulana Mazharul Haque Arabic & Persian University
- Caste certificate for SC/ST/OBC candidates.
- Three copies of recent passport size photograph pasted in application form.

### General Rules & Regulations

As per new NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Regulations 2014 and State Govt. rules.

### General Guidelines D 1

- A student admitted to S.T. College of Education must maintain an ethos of commitment to the professional programme in which he/she is enrolled. He/She is expected to aim at the highest in every sphere and to conduct himself/herself in a responsible and dignified manner wherever he/she may be.
- 2 (i) According to the Maulana Mazharul Haque Arabic & Persian University & Bihar School Examination Board, Patna regulations the trainees must attend 80% of all theory classes. Hence S.T. College of Education expects them to attend all classes. The trainees must attend all demonstration and criticism classes during the course and Scheduled Practice Teaching classes during October-November Practice Teaching period. The trainee is expected to teach in any school assigned by the college authority.
  - (ii) A trainee must also attend all college functions and activities such as cultural functions, seminars, symposia, debates, quizzes, essay competitions, sports, picnic, community services, exposure programmes, retreat etc.
  - (iii) Prior permission is required from the Principal for any absence either from theory or practical classes or community life activities.
  - (iv) It goes without saying that no commitment should be undertaken during the regular timings of the college classes and activities.
  - (v) The student's name is liable to be dropped from the rolls, if he/she is absent continuously for more than 10 days without leave. A re-admission fee will be charged, if re-admission is granted at all.
  - (vi) All are expected to attend the last working day before and first opening day after the vacations and short breaks. Those absent without prior leave will be fined.
- The college has a well-maintained computerized library of over 6,000 Books, Journals, Encyclopedias and Periodicals. Every student is expected to make the best use of it making sure, however, to observe the library rules fully.
- 4 Additional examinations from Cambridge University U.K for English Assessment will be offered. Though these are not compulsory, the trainees are encouraged to take advantage of the opportunity.
- 5 There will be four semester examinations and six content tests. Trainees must sit for all of them. The average of all will be taken for the internal assessment.
